

Brief History of The People's Improvement Trust

- Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar conceptualized the development of Public hall in 1938 and started generating fund
- The People's Improvement Trust (erstwhile The Scheduled Caste's Improvement Trust) was established by Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar in 1944
- Dr. Ambedkar appealed to The Princes and People of India to donate funds for development of Social Centre in Bombay
- With the funds generated, Trust purchased a piece of land admeasuring 1946 sq.m. at Gokuldas Pasta Lane, Dadar East, Mumbai in 1944
- The Scheduled Caste's Improvement Trust was registered under the Chairmanship of Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar in 1952
- Trustees in the year 2004 changed the name from The Scheduled Caste's Improvement Trust to The People's Improvement Trust for the benefit of the larger section of the society
- Constructed a building at a cost of Rs. 35000/- and shifted printed press (Bharat Bhushan printing press) from Naigaon to Current location in 1947. Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar used to pay a rent Rs. 50/- per month to the Trust for the premises of printing press

Development of Social Centre

- A small building of 40 ft x 50 ft was constructed in 1946 and then rented out for running Bharat Bhushan printing press
- MCGM in its first development plan of the year 1967, placed the plot under Secondary School reservation
- Existing structure has been constructed in the year 1973
- Trust requested Honorable Chief Minister, Govt. of Maharashtra in April 2015 for change in reservation of Secondary School over the Trust plot. Govt. of Maharashtra has changed the reservation to Public Hall and Institutional use in December 2015
- Total cost for the construction of 17 storey building with all the amenities is Rs. 60 crores, out of which Rs. 10.0 Crores has been sanctioned by Government of Maharashtra
- The Trust has to generate remaining funds of Rs. 50 crores through donations
